

## **Churchill College Boat Club Rules**

*Updated February 2019*

### 1. General Rules:

- i) During the dates of full term all current members of the club must abide by CUCBC (Cambridge University Combined Boat Clubs) rules.
- ii) In the event of dangerous weather conditions (as determined by the Overall Captain) no rowing is allowed.

### 2. Small Boats Rules

CUCBC rules on pairs/doubles:

- i) Pairs and doubles may go out without a banksteerer [bankparty] only if the steerer [rower] has at least a year's experience of steering small boats, and the permission of the club captain or boatman has been given. In addition, during Full Term, pairs and doubles must have a banksteerer outside the hours of 9am to 4pm or 30 minutes before lighting up if earlier.
- ii) That single sculls may go out without a banksteerer at any time if they have been declared competent as described in Section 3.
- iii) That all coaches of small boats should carry a throwline and a space blanket

### 3. Further CCBC Rules

- i) All users of CCBC's small boats must have had at least 10 outings with an experienced coach before going out unaccompanied.
- ii) That in the event that the coach is not content with the rower's competence after 10 outings they must do more before being signed off to go out unaccompanied.
- iii) Rower must be signed off as knowing how to store and maintain kit appropriately by the coach
- iv) Once this is done a form should be submitted to the Overall Captain stating that the individual is competent to row unaccompanied and can safely store the kit.
- v) The Overall Captain should make 3 copies of this form: one for the club, one for the rower and one as a spare.
